

Instructions for Mason Lock Box ® Maintenance EZ948

We recommend you maintain your Mason Lock Boxes ® minimum once every 12 month or more frequently if you are located in a dusty area. Use a spray such as Key Lube or LPS -1 or a dry Teflon lubricant on the cam lock. **DO NOT USE WD-40 as it will attract more dirt and dust.** Additionally, lightly spray or wipe onto and around the gasket a silicone paste to keep the gasket from freezing.

*If the lock does not open due to surface corrosion or grit, perform the following procedure.

- 1. Spray the lock cylinder generously with a good carburetor cleaner such as Gum Out, Poxylube or LPS-1. These products leave no residue and dissolve any grit that may be interfering with the moving parts of the lock.
- **2.** Take the master key and work it in and out of the lock several times.
- **3.** Spray the lock cylinder with a dry Teflon lubricant a second time.
